Castillo de San Marcos and Fort Matanzas



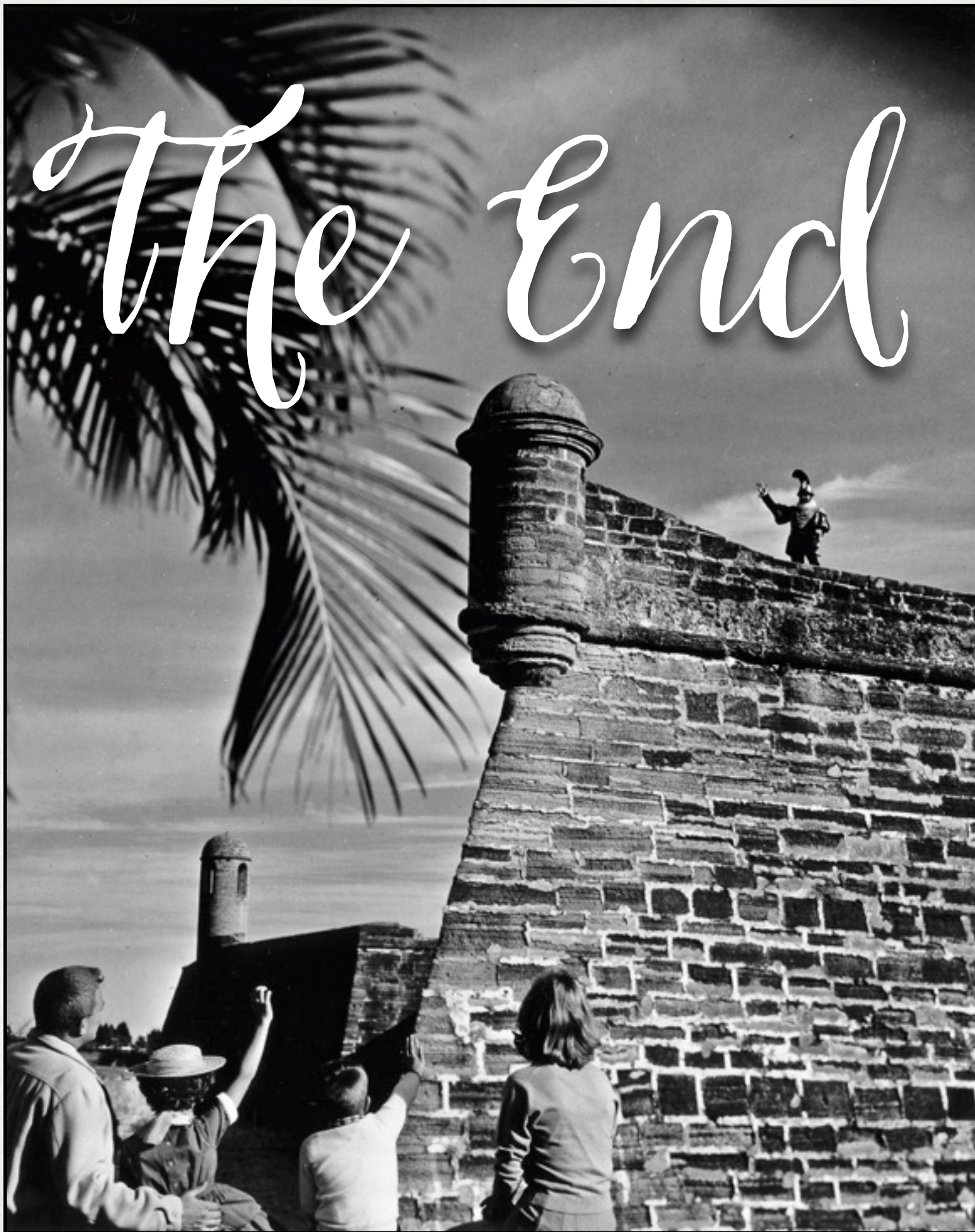
